EMERGENCY ANIMAL RESCUE

RELEASE FROM LIABILITY (*Read Carefully Before Signing*)

Be advised there are inherent risks, including the risk of serious injury or death, while engaging in equine activities. By engaging in equine activities and in accordance with the terms of this Agreement you hereby assume all risks of injury or death.

Rider intends to be legally bound hereby, for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives, successors and assigns, and voluntarily assumes all risk of accident or injury and releases and forever discharges Emergency Animal Rescue (E.A.R.) and its officers, agents, employees and personal representatives from any and all liability for personal injury, loss, or damage to person or property of any kinds sustained at the E.A.R Poker Ride to be held June 19, 2010, and all future dates of participation with E.A.R., whether such personal injury or property damage is caused by the negligence of Rider or E.A.R., its officers, agents or otherwise.

Rider is responsible for full and complete insurance coverage on his horse, personal property, and himself. Should medical treatment be required, Rider or Rider's own accident/medical insurance company shall pay for all such incurred expenses. Rider understands there are risks in and around equine activities.

Rider understands there are risks involved when not wearing protective headgear, and Rider acknowledges that E.A.R recommends such headgear, i.e. hardhat. If Rider chooses not to wear such protective headgear, he assumes any and all risks involved.

Rider agrees to indemnify and defend E.A.R. against, and hold harmless from any and all claims, demands, causes of action, damages, judgments, orders, costs or expenses, including attorneys' fees, which in any way arise from Rider's participation with E.A.R.
